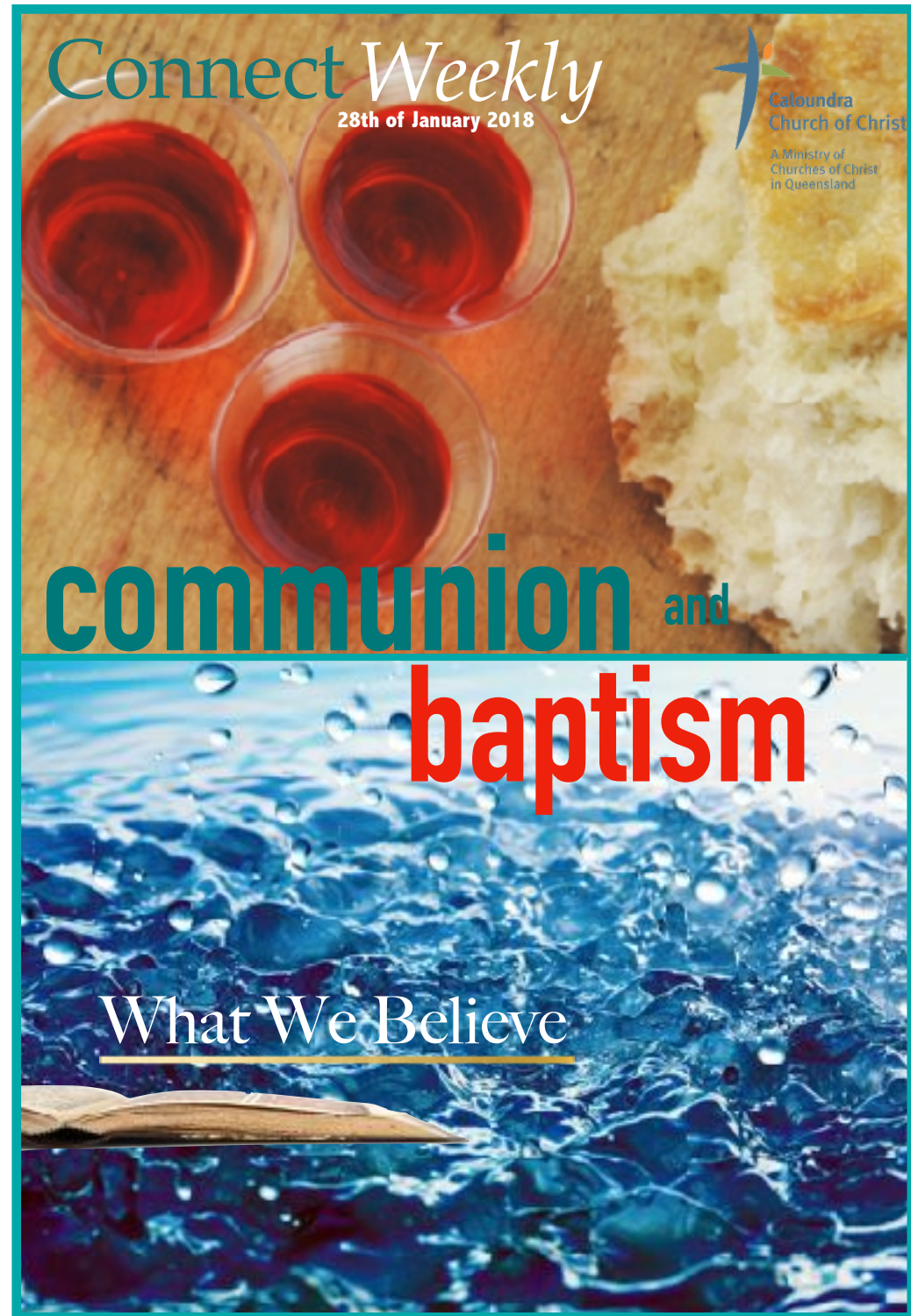

Emails from the church office

Our church database program, UCare has changed it's parent program and some of you have been having trouble receiving emails such as Prayer Prompts. There is a setting on your computer which hopefully will help. Following the instructions below will not affect anything else on your computer, but will ensure emails from UCare come through. If you use Outlook for your emails, in the top panel when you open the program you will see on the left hand side the word Junk with an arrow to the right of it. Click on the arrow and select Junk Email Options (the bottom of the drop down list). In the box that comes up, select 'Safe Senders'. You may have some addresses in the box that appears. If you have the address mail@ucareapp.com listed, please delete it. Then click on 'Add', re-enter mail@ucareapp.com and select apply and OK. If the address was not already in the box, still type it in, select apply and OK. You should now receive the emails. Once you have done the above steps, feel free to email the office and we can do a test for you. If you do not use Outlook, try to find your junk settings and look for the safe senders list. Again, please contact the office if you need any help and we will be happy to assist.

"What We Believe" Communion and Baptism.

Lord's Supper or Communion

1. It is an 'Open Communion'
2. Communion is observed each Sunday
3. We share this time with Christ

Baptism

1. Baptism is for the believer
2. Baptism is by immersion
3. What does Baptism have to do with my Salvation?
 - a. Ever since the day of Pentecost
Acts 2:38, 8:38, 9:18 16:33, 22:16; Romans 6, Galatians 3:27, 1 Peter 3:21
 - b. Under normal circumstances
 - It's Physically possible
 - A person has had the opportunity to hear and understand

Concluding Observations

The act of baptism does not save us - Jesus saves
Baptism is a demonstration of our acceptance of Jesus as our Saviour
Baptism is the point where we have the assurance of God's forgiveness.
Baptism should not be the subject of argument or division
