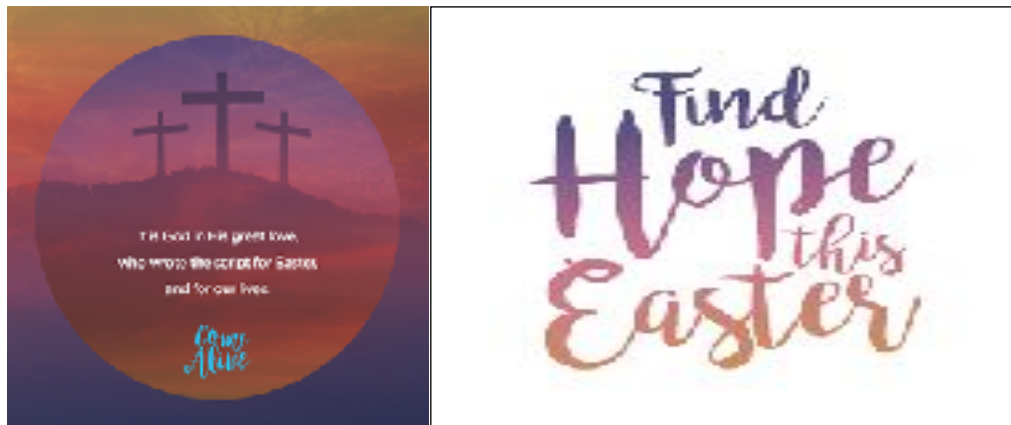
**POSITION VACANT:** Applications are invited for the position of Church Office Secretary for Caloundra Church of Christ.
