
Sunday Kids 9.30am today

POSITION VACANT: Applications are invited for the position of Church Office Secretary for Caloundra Church of Christ. Applicants associated with the church will be given precedence subject to qualifications and experience. Applicants are not required to be MEMBERS. The position is part-time, with a minimum of 20 hours per week (nominally 9am - 1pm) distributed evenly across Monday to Friday. Remuneration will be per the clerical award as published by Queensland Churches of Christ.

The position reports to the Office Manager and Senior Pastor as required.

While this is a clerical position, the applicant will be in constant contact with other staff, community visitors, volunteers and church members. Therefore, the person required should have a friendly disposition, be patient; and be able to cope with situations in a flexible and mature manner.

Sermon Notes

Intro: Today is Palm Sunday, when we are introduced to the Servant King who was so different from what people expected him to be.



• **John the Baptist** introduced **Jesus** as, 'The Lamb of God that takes away the sin of the world" John 1:29

Ap. John indicates that **Jesus** is, 'The Lamb that was slain from the creation of the world.' Rev 13:8

4 Simple Symbols:

1. A Donkey Luke 19:29-31
- 2 & 3. Cloaks & Palm Branches: Luke 19:35-36 ; 2 Kings 9:13; Mark 11:8; John 12:12-13; Luke 19:37
4. Rocks Luke 19:39-40

• **Up until now, Jesus** had been very guarded about his identity as '**Messiah**. 'Anointed one' is 'Christ' in Greek & 'Messiah' in Hebrew. Jesus rather identified himself as 'Son of Man. ' On Palm Sunday, **Jesus**, for the first time, openly acknowledges **his Kingship**.

A 2nd Procession. Pontius Pilate, the governor of Judea also led a procession of Roman soldiers into Jerusalem that day. Pilate's procession was a show of earthly military might and strength. Jesus' procession was designed to show the opposite.

- **Jesus**, for the first time, openly acknowledges **his Kingship**. Luke 22:67-71
- **Jesus** had spoken about the Kingdom of God in many parables, yet it is obvious that even his Disciples hadn't understood. Luke 24:21; John 12:16

Q. What about us? If we'd been there that day, how might we have responded?

- Paul's Summary of God's Purpose: Ephesians 1:4-6

Possible Lessons :

1. We are to obey Jesus when He tells us to do something.
2. Praise can be received with humility.
3. There is a time to be guarded about who we are in God, and there is a time to be fully open about it.
4. Jesus IS King! It is fitting that we worship Him!
